A one-day interactive multi-professional study day using experiential techniques to enable professionals working with children and young people with life threatening and life limiting conditions to:

- Recognise the child who is likely to be in the last few hours and days of life and understand the degree of uncertainty inherent within this
- Interpret and utilise an Advance Care plan or DNA-CPR order
- Be aware of the Rapid Discharge Plan and how to access advice and support to use the plan
- Understand the basic legal and ethical principles underpinning children's advance care planning, know when ethical or legal guidance may be needed and how to access it
- Support advance care planning discussions with a child and family
- Recognise when a child may benefit from advance care planning
- Be aware and able to access of external sources of support
